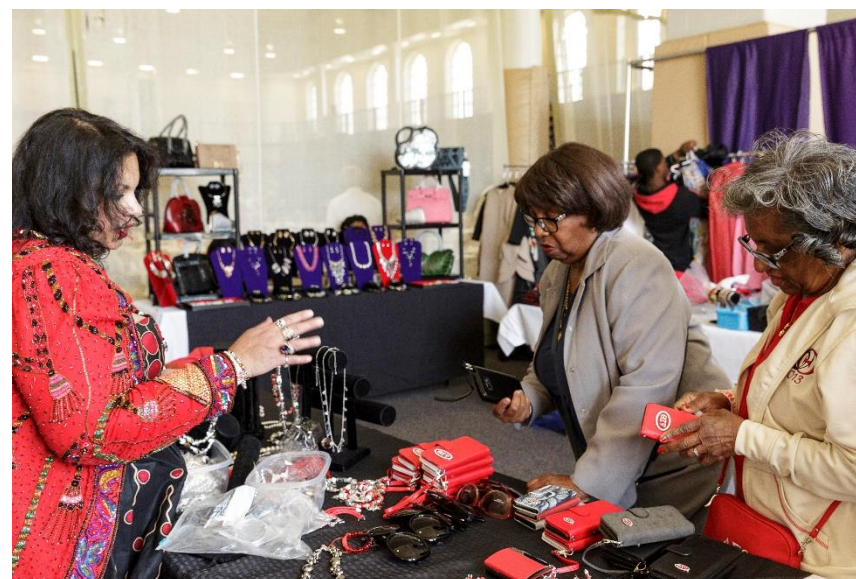
Vending spaces consist of a six-foot table with a white tablecloth and two chairs. The cost also includes:
